



Thrw Social brings experiential dining to Delray Beach

Entertainment entrepreneur Ginger Flesher-Sonnier has found success with an axe-throwing venue called Thrw Social, now open at 29 S.E. Second Ave. in Delray Beach.

The owner calls it her most exciting concept to date. The 12,000-square-foot “experiential dining and entertainment” hangout includes chef-driven cuisine, a mixology program, live music and DJs to accompany high-tech social games for adults in a tropical-themed setting.

A South Florida resident, Flesher-Sonnier runs Escape Room Live and the Kick Axe Throwing brand. She opened her first Thrw Social in Washington, D.C., and has other concepts in New York and Philadelphia. A former math teacher, she got her start in escape rooms after visiting one in Germany in 2014.

“People don’t want to go out and just sit a restaurant or bar anymore,” she said.
